**Eligibility**

Any Filipino, public or private entity with proven competence may apply, provided that projects fall under the specific research areas with overall goal to benefit Filipinos.

**Additional regulations**

The DOST Grants-in-Aid Guidelines shall govern in the approval and funding process of the successful project in the Philippines.

Budget restrictions may apply in accordance to issuances of the national government such as, but not limited to the adoption of economy measures in the Government.

DOST-PCHRD will also require the proponent to submit the following documents before the start of project implementation:

- Biosafety Clearance, if applicable
- Institutional Animal Care and Use Clearance, if applicable
- Bureau of Animal Industry Clearance, if applicable
- Ethics Clearance (for studies involving human subjects)
