National Research Council of Thailand (NRCT)

These regulations apply to Thai applicants for the Southeast Asia – Europe Joint Funding Scheme: 8th Call for Proposals.

NRCT can support projects in the area of

Circular Economy in the sub-topic as follows :

- The integration of agriculture (water-related projects e.g., irrigation, shall not be funded under this topic) and food security into circular economy
- Waste/disposal/leftover management and recycling
- Advanced Sensor Technologies, Artificial Intelligence and Remote Sensing for Waste Minimization
- Bio plastic focusing on food and pharmaceutical packaging

Eligibility

The applicants must have obtained Thai nationality who work in research institute or university, only legal entities established in Thailand, and are competent in conducting research with international partners.

Funding modalities

NRCT will provide support **1 – 3 projects** in the area of “**Circular Economy**” with the **maximum of three years**. The maximum funding is **up to 1,500,000 THB/per year/per project**.

Note: 1) The budget for a project may differ each year, depending on the content of activities and the exchange rate between Thai Baht and Euro may vary from time to time.

Submission

- 1) Proposals are to be submitted through the dedicated online tool (PT-OUTLINE). Link to the PT-Outline application tool: <https://ptoutline.eu>
- 2) After the project get selected from this Joint Research Projects, Thai principal investigators must submit the proposal format via NRIIS in accordance with NRCT regulation.
