#### What is the JFS?

The Southeast Asia (SEA) - Europe Joint Funding Scheme for Research and Innovation (JFS)

- Implements annual Joint Calls for Research Proposals
- Involves national or local funding agencies from Southeast Asia and Europe
- Funds bi-regional, multilateral research and innovation projects.

The coordination of the JFS is supported by the **European Commission (EC)**

## **Basic Principles**

#### **Annual Joint Calls for Research Proposals**

- Coordination: EC / Global Service Facility (GSF)
- Funders: Open to all national/local funders from SEA & Europe
- Funding Principle: No money crossing borders (exemptions for CLM possible)
- Thematic Areas: Jointly selected by funders
- 2+1 Rule: Project consortia must be bi-regional & multilateral





## **Basic Principles - Project consortium:**

Each project consortium: Bi-regional & multilateral

In total min. 3 partners from Southeast Asia & Europe

Min. 1 from **SEA** & 1 from **Europe** that is eligible for funding by JFS participating funders

$$\rightarrow$$
 2x SEA + 1x Europe or 2x Europe + 1x SEA

→ 2+1 Rule

Additional partners can join a consortium

Partners from "non-participating countries" need to bring own funding

**Coordinator** of project consortium must be eligible for funding





## **Management of Proposals**

#### **Eligibility Check**

- Call Secretariat: JFS rules
- National Focal Points (NFP): National Regulations

#### **Evaluation Step 1: Online Evaluation (min. 2/proposal)**

- Scientific/technical excellence / innovativeness of the project idea
- Potential impact and expected outcomes of the project / marketability
- Management, transnationality and cooperation

#### **Evaluation Step 2: Scientific Council**

- Review of each proposal and its online evaluations by 1st/2nd reader from scientific council
  - → Final ranking list of eligible proposals

#### **Funding Decision: Programme Steering Committee**



## Past Calls: 2017-2021

#### **JFS-Achievements**

- 7 Calls: bi-regional, multi-lateral
- 20 countries participated as funders
- 253 proposals received
- 55 projects funded
- 18 Mio. € granted for projects





- In the Menu Items "General Information", "Principal Project Coordinator", "Project Partners", data need to be filled as required by the forms.









#### **C. Upload Project Description**

- The full project description needs to be converted to PDF format and be uploaded.











#### D. Submit the Full Proposal

## **2023 JFS Call: Selected topics**

Two thematic areas were jointly selected during a conference call on 22 September 2023:

- Circular Economy (including Agriculture and Food security, not included water related projects)
- Clean, accessible and secure energy supply

### Important dates:

- Call 8 Launch: 1 December 2023
- Deadline of Submission: 15 April 2024, noon CEST
- Funding Decision Announcement: Early Oct 2024

## **Participating Funders**

- Each funder has own National Regulation for joining the JFS Collaboration, which is different from one to another please read thoroughly the Regulation stated by the funder in the JFS website. For example:
- Indonesia funder (BRIN) requests that Indonesian proponents must submit proposal earlier by email to BRIN at the latest of 23 February 2024 with documents requested by BRIN, for first selection (It is still negotiable).
- Brunei Darussalam, Universiti Malaya, Universiti Putra Malaysia, provide funding only for their own researchers.
- Switzerland (SNSF) makes available cross funding to Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, as far as they provide their own in-kind funding.
- Spain (CDTI-E.P.E.) provides funding to Spanish companies, which can be collaborated in national level with research centers, universities, etc.
